



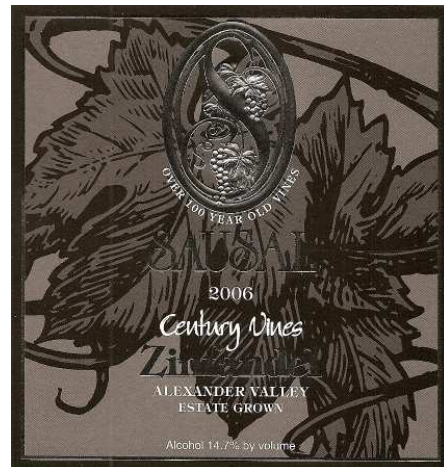

2006 Century Vines Zinfandel Alexander Valley

Our Century Vines Zinfandel is made from estate grown Zinfandel vines planted along Sausal Creek prior to 1877. These vines are still producing juice Sausal considers to have the truest varietal characteristics of any they have sampled.

The 2006 vintage has a dark garnet color, soon followed by a rich, full nose of floral, vanilla, cinnamon, and a hint of soft sweet cherry. Soft tannins lend themselves to a long silky, smooth finish.

The 2006 Century Vines Zinfandel is drinkable now, but with a few more years in the bottle will offer an even greater reward. Whether you enjoy it now, or cellar it for a few years, pair this wine with a juicy steak, wild game or marinated pork tenderloin.
